Training / quality requirements	Level 2, Helping Care and Welfare (Dutch: MBO Helpende Zorg en Welzijn niveau 2). First aid for children and baby's Certificate of good conduct (Dutch: VOG)
Registration	Compulsory registration at LRK (Dutch: Landelijk Register Kinderopvang). Takes up maximum of 10 weeks
Supervision on quality of the care	Contact with agency at least 2 times a year regarding safety and evaluation of the location of the care
Counseling	Entitled to receive guidance and counseling of childminding agency
